CLASSROOM SPOTLIGHT

Reception have had a busy term exploring and understanding the environments around them. We started off the term visiting Oaklands College Animal Habitat in St Albans where we saw lots of animals from Lemurs to Goats.

We've looked at books such as The Very Hungry Caterpillar, Camille and the Sunflowers and Jack and the beanstalk as well as non-fiction books about animals.

The children have learnt about the weather changes within the spring and have had a go at planting our own beans and sunflowers. We've looked at what plants need to grow and carried out our own experiments to see if we could change the colour of daisies.

We worked hard on our writing skills and have written sentences each week about the stories we have listened to, making sure we have beautiful formations and finger spaces. The class enjoyed dressing up as animals and pirates and we made our own Kites just like Argyle the Fox does in his book Argyle Fox by Marie Letourneau.
